The A&E team works hard to process applications as quickly as possible. The UCSA will confirm receipt of your application. It usually takes one month to process the application. You will be informed of the outcome.

Applications of up to \$999 are reviewed by the Activities and Events Committee who meet regularly. The committee consists of three people - one UCSA staff member and two students from the executive. Larger applications (for amounts of \$1,000 or more) are reviewed by the Student Executive. The terms and conditions for grants are covered in detail in the UCSA grants policy. In brief:
