UCSA Supreme Club Awards 2022 CRITERIA

Eligibility

Applicants must be affiliated to the UCSA

The club must have not breached of the UCSA Code of Conduct

The applications must be submitted before the nominations closing date to be considered for an award. The eligibility period for nominations is from 26th August 2021 to 24th August 2022.

Clubs must be nominated for most awards, but do not need to nominate themselves for the Supreme and Small Supreme Award. All clubs that are nominated for an award in any category will be considered in the running for these awards.

All awards will be judged by a panel comprised of UCSA staff and exec as appropriate. Indicative panel:

- UCSA President
- UCSA Student Executive Engagement Officer
- Events and Communications Manager
- UCSA International Events Coordinator
- Clubs Coordinator
- Reception Team Member

How to apply

- 1. Nominations will be accepted via the nomination form on our website. Specific questions will need to be answered so that the panel can more accurately compare applications.
- 2. The Awards panel shall select 4 finalists from the list of nominations to be considered for the Small Supreme Club and Big Supreme Club Awards.

Media Awards

Best Photo 2022

• This photo best captures what it means to be a part of this club.

Best Video 2022

• The video (max 1 minute) that best showcases the core of what the club or event offers and captures the student experience on campus.

Best Merchandise

• The item of merchandise that made people want to sign up to the club this year – be it a t-shirt, a cap, a singlet, whatever – The thing that everyone on campus wanted.

Best Graphic Design

• Best graphic design theme or item designed in-house by the club.

Best Event Marketing

• Celebrates excellence in original and effective event promotion

Excellence Awards

Best Sponsorship Opportunity

 Celebrates excellence in sponsor engagement. Generally, the opportunity will have been a success either financially or "in-kind", and will have been integrated in a seamless way.

Best Sustainability Initiative

• Celebrating excellence in sustainability initiatives to help promote a move towards a more sustainable future.

Best New Initiative or Event 2022

• Celebrating excellence new events, programmes or initiatives run for the first time during the eligibility period. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Arts Event 2022

Celebrating excellence in arts events. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Cultural Event 2022

Celebrating excellence in cultural events. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Academic Programme or Event 2022

• Celebrating excellence in academic programmes or events. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Business Event or Workshop 2022

 Celebrating excellence in business focussed events or workshops. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Community Event 2022

• Celebrating excellence in community events. A community event is an event delivered to meet local community needs or cause-related fundraising or awareness-raising event or building relationships within the community. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Health and Well-being Event 2022

 Celebrating excellence in health and well-being focussed events. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Social Event Programme 2022

 Celebrating excellence in social event programmes. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Sports Event 2022

Celebrating excellence in sporting events. Event budget / club size is irrelevant.

Best Major Event 2022

• Celebrating excellence in the large club run events on campus, which require a huge commitment to deliver.

Best Response to Adversity Event 2022

 This award recognises an exceptional response by clubs to challenges posed by significant external factors, including but not limited to Covid-19, permitted the event still went ahead in some capacity. This must be something entirely outside of the club's control – not leaving everything to the last minute!

Recognition Awards

Individual Contribution Awards

Recognising the huge level of work done by club executives. These awards will
generally be presented to outgoing executive who have had held a number or
roles in one or more clubs and have often gone above and beyond in completing
these roles and contributing to the club scene at UC.

Supreme Awards

UC's Supreme Event (as voted by students)

- All finalists from the Excellence Award categories will automatically gain entry to this Award.
- The event receiving the most votes from the public during the voting timeline, will win UC's Supreme Event 2022.

Supreme Individual Contribution to Clubs Award

- Recognising the individual who has made an outstanding contribution to the club scene at UC.
- All finalists for an Individual Contribution Award will be considered category.

Supreme New Club

 Recognising the club or society that has burst onto the scene, affiliating with the UCSA for the first time this year, who has best exceeded their own aims and ambitions for their first year.

Supreme Small Club (less than 200 members)

- The club or society with less than 200 members that has exceeded expectations this year, who is the best on campus at what they do, in contributing to its members, the student body, and the wider community, and have gone above and beyond.
- All clubs who are NOMINATED in another category and have less than 200 members as per the membership lists supplied to the UCSA are eligible.

Supreme Big Club (200+ members)

- The club or society with more than 200 members that has exceeded expectations
 this year, who is the best on campus at what they do, in contributing to its
 members, the student body, and the wider community, and have gone above and
 beyond.
- All clubs who are NOMINATED in another category and have 200 or more members as per the membership lists supplied to the UCSA are eligible
